## Enrollment Report: Fall Semesters 2005-2009

### Overview and Definitions

The purpose of this report is to provide student enrollment trends for the fall semesters of the past five years. Enrollment statistics presented in this report are based on data extracted from the Banner student information systems as of the official census date of the Fall 2009 term. Tables in this report present student enrollment by the following factors:

- **Class Load** (Full and Part Time)

Students who are enrolled in courses that total 12 or more credit hours are classified as full time. Those who are enrolled in less than 12 credit hours are classified as part time students.

- **Persistence** (Fall-to-Fall Retention)

Fall-to-Fall persistence represents the number of students who were enrolled (as of the official census date) in the respective term and were also enrolled (again, as of the official census date) in the subsequent fall term. Persistence rates for 2007, 2008 AND 2009 were calculated using data extracted from the Banner student information system as of the census date for fall 2008; thus differences in persistence rates from prior years may be due to technical reasons rather than actual changes in rates.

- **Tenure at Oakton** (New and Returning)

Students are considered new to Oakton if their first term at Oakton is the fall or preceding summer term. New students are not limited to recent high school graduates.

- **Campus** (Des Plaines only, Skokie only, On-line/off-campus only, Combinations)

Oakton students attend classes at more than one location; therefore, data show students who attend in Des Plaines only, Skokie only, on-line/off campus only, and various combinations.

- **Instructional Method** (Face-to-Face, Distance Learning)

Instructional method is determined by examining how courses are taught. Categories represent all possible combinations of two methods of instruction: Face-to-Face and Distance Learning. For presentation purposes, courses that use online, media-based, TV or video instruction have been collapsed into a single "Distance Learning" category.

- **Time of Day** (Day, Evening, Weekend, Online)

Time of day is determined by examining when the courses are taken. Categories represent all possible combinations of three times: Day, Evening, and Weekend and/or Online. For presentation purposes, courses that are taught on the weekend or online (i.e., without a specified time of day) have been collapsed into a single "Weekend and/or Online" category.

- **Academic Program** (Transfer, Career and Undecided Programs)

Academic program is based on the student-reported program of study, usually at the time of admission. We break out Undecided students. In some other reports Undecided students are categorized as Liberal Arts Transfer.

- **Demographics**

Students' gender, date of birth, and ethnicity are collected at the time of admission.

- **Residency**

Breakdown by city is derived from the zip code of each student's residence. Some out-of-district students who are employed full-time within the district may pay in-district tuition through the College's Business Service Agreement.

- **High Schools**

Recent high school graduates (of the last two graduating classes) from in-district, out-of-district, and out-of-state/country high schools are reported along with a breakdown by in-district high schools.
