This scholarship is made possible by the generosity of the Ernest C. Wentcher Educational Fund, with the Oakton Community College Educational Foundation serving as its agent. Ten (10) annual scholarships are available for attendance at Oakton, each valued at \$2,500 per year. Scholarships may be renewed for the following academic year based on sufficient funding and minimum grade point average. The scholarship cannot exceed the cost of tuition, fees, books, and supplies as listed on the course syllabus.

Requirements:

- 3.0 grade point average
- Full-time enrollment (12+ credit hours)
- U.S. Citizenship
- Recent copy of high school transcript
- Completed scholarship application and essay
- Personal interview at Oakton Community College (an appointment will be scheduled)

Applications will be considered based on the following criteria: academic program, educational goals, grade point average, campus/community involvement, application content and quality. Preference will be given to high school students graduating in June 2009.

Application deadline: Friday, May 1, 2009, at 5 p.m. at the Office of Student Financial Assistance, Room 1250 (Des Plaines) or Room A100 (Ray Hartstein Campus). The Office of Student Financial Assistance will notify students of their application status in the spring.
