Cantonese is a major dialect of Chinese, and is the official language of Hong Kong. If you are considering travel there for business or pleasure, or to Guangdong Province in southern China or Macao, a working knowledge of Cantonese will be extremely useful. Cantonese is the language of the people in all of these places, as well as in sizable Chinese communities in the U.S. and Canada. You will learn basic conversation, listening skills and basic reading and writing. A required materials fee of \$15 is payable to the instructor at the first class session. No senior discount.
