## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The workshop is designed for professionals working with survivors of domestic violence. The experiential workshop promotes learning and discussion beyond theory, extending to practice and implementation. Participants will leave understanding and recognizing trauma-informed care. Topics covered include:

- understanding trauma-informed care,
- parallel processes and vicarious trauma,
- trauma and triggers, and
- creating safety.

- Explore the behavioral, social, and emotional presentations of trauma, and identify the appropriate trauma informed responses
- Examine barriers and solutions to implementation of trauma informed care
