Area G: Electives

To determine number of electives needed add hours in Areas A through F and subtract from 60.

Electives can be in **any** college level courses offered at Oakton. **Limitations:** Student can use up to 4 hours of Physical Education courses (activity courses) and up to 7 hours of career / vocational courses.

- ① Developmental courses **do not** count towards credit hours needed for graduation.
② Courses can fulfill both the Global Studies **and** either a social/behavioral science **or** humanities/fine arts requirement.
③ Maximum of 45 credits earned at other colleges can be applied to meet degree requirements
