

**Time of Registration & Course Success**

As part of the research done for the Educational Policies and Procedures Task Force project, the Office of Research staff examined time students registered for their classes and their success, with success defined as grades of A, B, C in college-level courses and P in developmental courses. Data below are from Fall 2003; a similar pattern was found for Spring 2004. We excluded media based courses. Data depict the percentage of students successful in their classes by registration time.
