Enrollment Report: Fall Semesters 2003 - 2007

Overview and Definitions

The purpose of this report is to provide student enrollment trends for the fall semesters of the past five years. All enrollment statistics presented in this report are based on data extracted from the Banner student information systems as of the official census date (tenth day) of the *Fall 2007 term*.

Note that the current report format has been updated to include new student and enrollment characteristics that were not able to be replicated with data collected for previous years' enrollment reports. Thus, data for all prior terms was extracted from our student database, along with the current term's data, in Fall 2007. As a result of updates to student records between the previous fall terms and the current data extraction, counts for some characteristics may not exactly match those listed in previous Fall Enrollment Reports for the same term, although such variations should still be minimal.

Tables in this report present student enrollment by the following factors for all students enrolled at Oakton, as well as comparable tables for students enrolled in courses at each of Oakton's campuses:

- **Class Load** (*Full and Part Time*)

Students who are enrolled in courses that total 12 or more credit hours are classified as full time. Those who are enrolled in less than 12 credit hours are classified as part time students.

- **Retention** (*Fall-to-Fall Retention*)

Fall-to-Fall retention represents the number of students who were enrolled (as of the official census date) in the respective term and were also enrolled (again, as of the official census date) in the subsequent fall term.

- **Tenure at Oakton** (*New and Returning*)

Students are considered new to Oakton if their first term at Oakton is the fall or preceding summer term. New students are not limited to recent high school graduates.

- **Campus of Enrollment** (*Des Plaines, Skokie, Off-Campus, Online*)

Campus of enrollment is determined by where *each* of a student's courses are taken. Categories represent all possible combinations of three "campuses": Des Plaines, Skokie, and Off-Campus and/or Online. For presentation purposes, off-campus and online courses classes have been collapsed into a single category.

- **Instructional Method** (*Face-to-Face, Distance Learning*)

Instructional method is determined by examining how *each* of a student's courses are taught. Categories represent all possible combinations of two methods of instruction: Face-to-Face and Distance Learning. For presentation purposes, courses that utilize online, media-based, TV or video instruction have been collapsed into a single "Distance Learning" category.

- **Time of Day** (*Day, Evening, Weekend, Distance Learning*)

Time of day is determined by examining when *each* of a student's courses are taken. Categories represent all possible combinations of three times: Day, Evening, and Weekend and/or Distance Learning. For presentation purposes, courses that are taught on the weekend or via distance learning methods (i.e., without a specified time of day) have been collapsed into a single "Weekend and/or Dist. Learn." category.

- **Academic Program** (*Transfer and Career Programs*)

Academic program is based on the student-reported program of study, usually at the time of admission. A category for undecided was added in Fall 2002.

- **Demographics**

Students' gender, date of birth, and ethnicity are collected at the time of admission.

- **Residency** (*In-District and Out-of-District*)

In-district or out-of-district is determined at time of enrollment in each fall semester and based on residency and tuition rates. Students who live in the district or attend Oakton on a business service agreement pay in-district tuition and are classified "in-district". Breakdown by city is derived from the zip code of each student's residence.

- **High Schools** (*In-District Public, In-District Private and Out-of-District*)

Recent high school graduates (of the two graduating classes prior to each respective term) from in-district, out-of-district, and out-of-state/country high schools are reported for each term.
