



**Where After Oakton?
A Report of Attendance at Colleges and Universities After Oakton**

Introduction

The purpose of this report is to present data about the number and characteristics of Oakton students who attend other colleges and universities after leaving Oakton. Because one of Oakton's primary *raison d'être*s is to prepare students for transfer, and 43 percent of students indicate they are in a transfer curriculum, it is particularly important for the College to understand whether students are, indeed, moving to other institutions after leaving Oakton.¹

Methodology

Using data from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) EnrollmentVerify program, the Office of Research looked at students who met the following characteristics:

- Last attended Oakton from Fall 2005 through Summer 2008;
- Did not report having a bachelors degree or higher, or having attended a foreign college, when they applied to Oakton;²
- Attended Oakton after high school;³

² Some students may have stopped out from Oakton, earned a bachelors degree and then returned. Data in the student information system do not permit us to identify this pattern of behavior if the student has not reapplied to Oakton, something we do not require students to do if they return to Oakton within three years of departure. We also excluded attendees of foreign colleges because data do not reflect degrees earned outside the United States.

- Attended at least one Fall or Spring semester.⁴

The National Student Clearinghouse includes data on college and university attendance for more than 90 percent of students enrolled in United States colleges and universities. The NSC matches students based on name and birthdate, not social security number. Oakton submitted data for the 15,518 students who met the characteristics noted above. The NSC found matches for 15,006 of them.

We then matched student records returned from the NSC with records from Oakton's student system. This enabled us to extract the following data about each student:

- Gender
- Age when departed from Oakton
- Race / ethnicity based on students' self identification⁵
- Program of study at Oakton (career or transfer, with undecided treated as transfer)
- Placement in writing and mathematics at Oakton
- Credits earned at Oakton (college-level courses)
- Grade point average earned at Oakton (college-level courses)

In the next section we compare students who attended another college or university after Oakton with those who did not, using each of the variables listed above. We also provide a list of all colleges and universities attended after Oakton, recognizing that some students attend more than one institution and are reported for each one. This list, then, is a duplicated headcount of students.

It is important to note that these data tell us whether a student attended another institution, and where. They do not depict whether students officially transferred or whether the receiving institution accepted Oakton credits. Nor do they tell us whether students earned degrees after transfer.

It is also important to keep in mind that the report is descriptive. Moreover, because we are looking at the entire population of Oakton students who met our criteria for inclusion in the study, it would be inappropriate to conduct tests of statistical significance that tell us the probability of sample results being representative of a larger population.

We do not make assumptions that student characteristics are causally related to attending another institution after Oakton. Before conducting this type of study we need first to understand the attributes of students who transfer. For a more complete picture it would also be important to obtain information about financial assistance received by students both at Oakton and at subsequent institutions because research nationally demonstrates that financial

⁵ Due to new federal reporting requirements for race/ethnicity, we no longer have a category of 'Other' for race/ethnicity. Students who in the past were able to identify as 'Other' are now represented in the same category as students who say they 'Choose not to respond' to the question on the Oakton Application that asks for race/ethnicity.

aid is a critical factor affecting students' access to and persistence through postsecondary education.

Even with these limitations, the data below provide important insights about student behavior at and after Oakton.

Results

Table 1 provides demographic and academic data describing students in the populations studied and the number and percent who attended at least one other college or university after Oakton. Overall, 44 percent of students went elsewhere after Oakton. There were no differences in mobility rate by gender; younger students had a higher mobility rate than older students; Asians had the highest rate of all ethnic groups although the large number of students who did not provide a race/ethnicity identification make the data problematic to interpret; students in transfer programs had a higher mobility rate than students in CTE or undecided students; and students whose academic skills upon entry were stronger (judged by composition and mathematics placements) and who earned higher grade point averages and more credits were more likely to attend elsewhere after Oakton.

What is perhaps most interesting is that while data reflect some generally expected patterns, such as students in transfer programs having a higher rate of mobility than students in CTE programs, the overall pattern demonstrates that moving to another college or university occurs among all student groups. Most important, perhaps, is that students in CTE programs do not terminate their educations at Oakton, and that a good number of students who begin at the developmental level do move to other colleges and universities. Note data reported in this study do not examine whether students took developmental courses at Oakton and attained college-level competency. This will be a subsequent study.

Table 2 lists the colleges and universities that received at least 50 students from Oakton. "Receive" means an Oakton student enrolled at the institution after his or her last term at Oakton. Notably, institutions with the largest draw are in the Chicago area and mobility among community colleges is high. Eight of the 26 schools are Illinois public community colleges.

Finally, Table 3 lists all institutions attended by these Oakton students after they left the College. As in Table 2, numbers are duplicated headcounts, so a student attending two institutions is counted once in each. The National Student Clearinghouse uses separate identification codes for institutions we may think of as being the same; e.g., Argosy University. We retained the unique NSC identification so as not to assume the same student attended each site of what we would consider the "same" college.

Perhaps the most compelling finding in Table 3 is the large number of colleges and universities Oakton students attend after leaving the College. A total of 636 institutions were listed. Even if some could be combined into a single college or university; e.g., if all Argosy University entries were considered to be one institution, the number would still be very large.

Observations

This brief study demonstrates that Oakton students leave the College and attend numerous other colleges and universities across the country. Students whose academic records are stronger are more likely to go elsewhere, but so do a large number of students whose grade point averages are relatively weak and who earn relatively few credits at Oakton. A substantial amount of mobility takes place among community colleges, a transfer picture often ignored in the literature, which focuses on transfer from two-year to four-year institutions. It is also important to note that a substantial number of students in Career and Technical Education programs move on to other colleges and universities, suggesting the College continue to provide transfer information to all students and not just those who identify themselves to be in transfer programs.

The National Student Clearinghouse is a resource providing unique and important information about student mobility. The Office of Research welcomes comments and suggestions for additional research.
