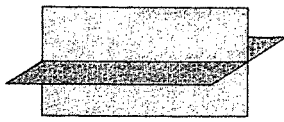
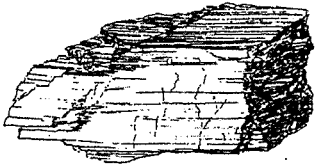
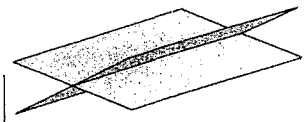
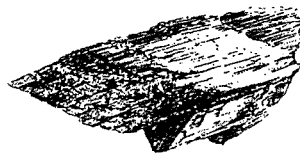


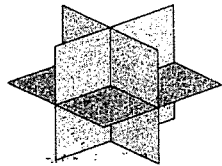
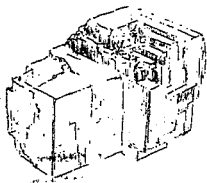
A. Cleavage in one direction.
Example: muscovite.



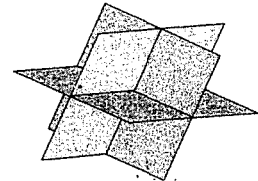
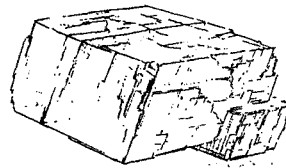
B. Cleavage in two directions at right angles.
Example: feldspar.



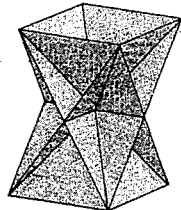
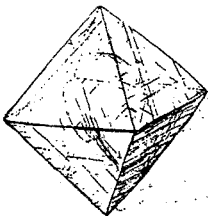
C. Cleavage in two directions not at right angles.
Example: amphibole.



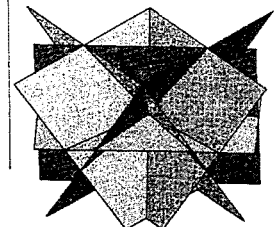
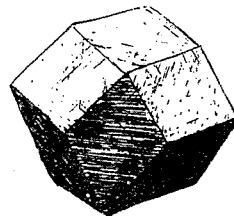
D. Cleavage in three directions at right angles.
